## **PREFACE**

The present study is an attempt to examine the development impact of mobile telephony led growth of telecommunications in India. The growth of mobile telephones in the past 4 to 5 years has been breathtaking, allowing the country to leap frog to a status of reasonable parity with other countries. Unprecedented growth at this pace has had spin-offs both positive and negative, but the intuitive premise of this study that the positive effects outweigh the negatives has been vindicated by the results and conclusions.

- 2. In consolidating research in the area and drawing policy lessons for the future, world-wide experience and trends have been taken into account, while at the same time concentrating on India-specific constraints and circumstances.
- 3. I hope that the study will add perspective and further meaning to the large body of work being undertaken in the field.
